

Whale Shark Snorkel

Extend your trip with an exciting day snorkeling with whale sharks in Mexico's Bay of La Paz. Set off in a skiff and observe the whale sharks, the largest fish in the sea, alongside dolphins and tropical fish on an incredible underwater excursion.

Once a whale shark is spotted, hop into the water like a paratrooper and take off on your swim alongside the ocean's gentle giants. Watch their gaping mouths engulf mass amounts of plankton and anything else in their paths as they slowly glide along. The juvenile whale sharks in La Paz are a whopping 7-10 meters long with mouths that yawn open over 5 feet, yet they're no Moby Dick with their mild disposition. It's rare to experience something as awe-inspiring as swimming alongside these mammoth, polka-dotted creatures that course the Sea of Cortez.

A local whale shark specialist accompanies you on your swim. We partner with local conservation biologist and Director of [Whale Shark México](#), Dení Ramírez Macías. In addition to their other conservation efforts, Macías and Whale Shark México have worked with tourist companies to promote sustainable marine-based tourist activities. Their efforts and passion for whale sharks are obvious as they work to make your time swimming in La Paz educative, meaningful, and memorable.
